The following is probably a simple question for anyone familiar with regular expressions, but I am still trying to learn the STREGEX function.

Suppose I want to find the first occurence in a string of an 'I' ithat is not part of a double 'I'. For example, in the string

IDL> st = 'The rolling hills and lake'

I want to return the character position of the 'l' in lake (=21).

The following expression almost works -- it will search for any 'l' which is both preceded and followed by anything that is not "I"

IDL> print,stregex(st, '[^I]I[^I]')

but it won't work for the string 'The rolling hills and pool' because the final 'I' has no characters following it. Any suggestions?
