try this:

```
(add-hook 'idlwave-shell-mode-hook
  (lambda ()
    (define-key idlwave-shell-mode-map "\C-p" 'idlwave-shell-up-or-history)
    (define-key idlwave-shell-mode-map "\C-n" 'idlwave-shell-down-or-history)))
```
