I've never used the Build command, so I don't have any idea what might be wrong here. But I've never had any trouble with modal widgets in save files either. (I wouldn't know about external programs, as I never use them. Everything I've ever wanted to do could be done in IDL. :-)

I'd try building the save file by hand. Here are instructions that have always worked for me.
