I would like to use postscript fonts for the labels in a shade\_surf plot, because the vector drawn fonts are hard to read and not nice-looking. But IDL (5.2) vertically stacks one letter on top of the other for the Z-axis when I set the FONT=0 (choosing PS fonts). I'd like to have the Z-axis label rotated 90 degrees (normal typeset, but rotated), which is what happens when using the vector drawn fonts. I don't see any way to do this, but there \_must\_ be a way, can anyone tell me how?
