> Dear Emacs users,  
>  
> It's been more than two years (April 1999) since I took over the Emacs  
> IDL mode, now called IDLWAVE. After a hot initial phase with a full  
> overhaul of the entire package, lots of new features added and old  
> bugs removed, things have slowed down recently. Those of you who have  
> sent me bug reports or feature requests will have noticed, that reply  
> and bug-fixing action has been slow if happening at all. This is  
> certainly an unsatisfactory situation.  
>  
> On the other hand, a few milestones have been reached. Some weeks ago  
> Emacs 21 was released with IDLWAVE as an integrated package and the  
> default mode for all ".pro" files. Most importantly, IDLWAVE made it  
> into David Fannings marvelous collection of useful IDL tips  
> ([http://www.dfanning.com/misc\\_tips/idlemacs.html](http://www.dfanning.com/misc_tips/idlemacs.html)) and even has been  
> "Tip of the Month"! Now, \*that\* seems hard to top.  
>  
> So for two quite different reasons it seems to be about time for me to  
> resign as maintainer. IDLWAVE will continue to be maintained and  
> developed, stay tuned for the announcement by the new maintainer soon.  
> I will still be around, helping to fix things, but also actually using  
> IDL instead of writing Emacs code.  
>  
> This whole thing has been great fun and I have certainly learned a  
> lot. I hope IDLWAVE has been and will continue to be useful to many  
> people here. Thank you all for your encouragement and feedback.  
>
