> Is there a way of creating a top-level base with a bitmap background?

>

Look at the demo source code (on windows the path is rsi/idl5x/examples/demo/demosrc). It is fairly simple to do with a bulletin board widget\_base. The nice thing about the demo source is that it has the "tweaks" for all the different platforms.

> As for the latter, I've managed to create a coloured base using

> resources (yes that's right I'm using X-windows on a VMS Alpha).

> However, I am unable to create "whited out" input areas. they always

> have the same colour as the base widget.

It has been awhile since I have been on VMS alpha, but David Fanning's coyote\_field gives a constant white background on Windows and Mac (and UNIX too?).
