Hi,

I have defined an object and all methods are located in the same <object>\_\_define.pro file. When I create a new instance of the object for the first time, the routine <object>\_\_define is compiled and the method <objects>::INIT is executed properly. When destroying the object the <objects>::CLEANUP routine is executed. All other methods are not compiled and therefore unknown to IDL.

Is there a way to automatically compile all other methods of the object (e.g. by using RESOLVE\_ROUTINE in the <object>\_\_define routine)?
