I think the answer to the following question is "no" but it is worth a shot.

Is there any way to determine if a user-defined plotting symbol has been created using USERSYM for plotting with PSYM=8? (I suppose it might also be nice if one could determine what the user-defined symbol actually is, i.e. fetch the X,Y vectors that were input to USERSYM, but I don't need that now.)

I want to have my plotting program use the current USERSYM definition for PSYM=8 if it exists, but to create a default symbol if no current USERSYM definition exists.
