- Start VersaTerm Pro
- Start MacX
- 3. Start IDL from VT Pro
- 4. Try to open X-window from IDL
- 5. Did it work?

Yes --> Don't quit IDL!

No --> Quit MacX. Goto 2.

- (3) Copy in MacX 1.1.7 and run it.
- (4) Run IDL; the only remaining difficulties are in chosing colors. I like -84, but nothing is perfectly satisfactory.

Retreating to MacX 1.1.7 fixed the problems for me, too. I got a copy from Apple by calling 1-800-767-2775, explaining the problem to them, and sending some proof that I had purchased MacX 1.2.
