```
seed  = LONG( (SYSTIME(1) - LONG(SYSTIME(1))) * 1.e6 )
randnum = RANDOMU(seed, 1)
print, randnum, format='(f27.25)'
```

For your purpose, the value of "seed" might be used in the filename.
