Yesterday someone tolds me thats it is possible to have uncompressed gif. Did someone know if rsi would implement this kind of format again in this mode.

My slow motion animation of about 20 to 100 images would be best stored in gif. Because in difference to the other formats I can set a wait time to each frame. It looks like that's an uncompressed gif is smaller as a compressed mpeg multiplied the frames by 24.
