> but when I run it with idlrt, it reports:
> "Attempt to call undefined procedure/function: 'WRITE_IMAGE'"
>
> SAVE, FILENAME = '<filename.sav>',$
>   /ROUTINES,$
>   /verbose,$
>   'WRITE_IMAGE', .....
>
>
> How should I declare the WRITE_IMAGE in the SAVE procedure?
```

You don't have to "declare" it. You just have to have it compiled at the time you save all your other compiled routines. Have you forgotten to do a RESOLVE\_ALL before you save the file?
