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Hello all,

I'm trying to overlap coastal boundaries to a METEOSAT image (B format, that covers the European, North African and Middle East regions) with the MAP\_SET command.

I need to use the native projection -geostationary- and specify the LIMIT option as an eight-element vector, although the top pixels are on space. I try to substitute them with the extreme coordinates on Earth's visible disc, but the boundaries don't match properly.
