Yes, it's not on by default. You have to configure the variable `idlwave-expand-generic-end`. The easiest way is to M-x `customize-variable` it. Or you can examine the ".emacs" sections of the manual which shows this being set with other settings in your customization file. That one saves me lots of times, especially when I forget where I am in some deeply nested `if..then..else..if` block.
