- > This only works on about half of the points. Only the points that are East of
- > Greenwich are plotted, and nothing west. Anyone have any suggestions?

IDL User's Manual 3.5 p 19-16 says "... lines with length exceeding a certain value will not be drawn. The critical value depends on the projection. Problems with drawing lines may occur when lengths exceed 75% of the length or width of the map. In that case, simply break the line into shorter line segments."

It's not clear why this would lead to points E but not W of Greenwich being plotted, but anyway, try adding some intermediate points.

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
