
Subject: How to do nested objects??

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I have a class that I want to have hold another object. My code compiles without error, however, when I try to run it, I get the error:

```

The contained object is:

```
PRO JWR_CAL_Image_File_Names__define
struct = { JWR_CAL_Image_File_Names, InFileNames:STRARR(251) }
END ; PRO JWR_CAL_Image_File_Names__define
```

The containing object is:

```
PRO JWR_CalibrationNotes__define
struct = { JWR_CalibrationNotes, InFileName:", $
PathToDataFiles:", $
NumberOfNotes:0, $
NotesArray:OBJARR(80), $
CalibImageFileNames:JWR_CAL_Image_File_Names, ROIFileIDs:LONARR(4) }
END ; PRO JWR_CalibrationNotes__define
```

I get the error message quoted above when I try to create the containing object:

```
PRO MultiSpectralCalibration
; Create Calibration File List Object

CFL = OBJ_NEW( 'JWR_CalibrationNotes' )

OBJ_DESTROY, CFL
END ; PRO MultiSpectralCalibration
```
