I think there must be some kind of detrimental interaction going on between the CENTRAL\_AZIMUTH keyword on the MAP\_SET command and the MAP\_PATCH routine. If you leave CENTRAL\_AZIMUTH off, or use MAP\_IMAGE instead of MAP\_PATCH, things appear to work correctly.

I think this is a bug that should be reported.
