The .max format is the new 3d studio max file format. I don't think the spec has been published and there doesn't seem to be any freeware/shareware programs that will read/convert them.

You'll need either 3ds max or a commercial converter like PolyTrans (~\$400 US) or Deep Exploration (starting at \$300 US)
