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A question - which IDL experts may consider trivial:

I have the need to pass functions $f(x,y,z,...) = ...$ from the IDL environment to a C language library, but cannot find information describing the technique - assuming it exists.

As an example, suppose I define a function of one variable $r(t)$ in IDL, then require some max/min/root over a defined domain. Also suppose I have the greatest rootfinder known since the Krell in a C library compiled to a DLM.

How/Can I pass $r(t)$ to the rootfinder for evaluation?
