Hi folks...

map_set is giving me some headache since days...I'm trying to create in batch modus under linux some maps (shell script is calling up IDL and starting the progs). The problem is this

When calling map_set while being in the batch routines with the following arguments:

```
map_set,47.6445,9.29510,LIMIT=[47.4520,8.77010,47.8370,9.820 10]
```

IDL returns:

```
MAP_SET_LIMITS: Warning, MAP limits are invalid.
```

Well, If I just state this command not being in the batch modus: everything is going to be fine....

Any ideas? are the !MAP parameters messed up? Is there a way to set them back to standards? I tried also the SCALE keyword, which works, but because I got quite a bunch of maps with different scales...no way.... Thanks for your hints in advance...
