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It is indeed amazing to watch IDL for Windows disable any kind of multitasking offered by the operating system. However, even with MSVDM you run into problems when IDL gets stuck in one of their system routines. I managed to set triangulate into an endless loop (bug in IDL) with the result: Rien ne va plus...
