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The ION page on RSI's website (<http://www.rsinc.com/ion/>) gives the wavelet demo (<http://ion.researchsystems.com/IONScript/wavelet/>). One nice feature of this demo is the ability to save the output image as a postscript (or EPS) file. However, as far as I can tell from the ION/Script documentation the only available output image formats are PNG, PNG24 and JPEG24. The source code is not available for this site -- perhaps they use some non-ION/Script elements to get the postscript output?

What I would really like to do is be able to output a binary (FITS) file after the user has modified an image.
