I've been asked to investigate the possibility of embedding an IDL application into a web page. Obviously ION is the only possibility. But when I went to the RSI web page for information and tried the ION example I was, uh, less than impressed.

It takes several minutes to load, then the images are not centered in the windows, and when I move the slider bars to look at the images, anything cut off my my window disappears. In seconds (this is *\*fast\**), my entire image has disappeared. :-(

I know slick example programs are not really RSI's thing, but is that what I can expect with ION? Has anyone used it in a realistic way? My customer would like a fair amount of interactivity and at the moment I'm feeling fairly pessimistic.
