> We recently moved all our SPARCstations to SunOS 4.1.2 and have discovered  
> that many routines in PV-Wave (e.g. tvscl) now get a segmentation fault.

> Has anyone else seen this?

We have been experiencing some problems with SunOS 4.1.2 but only when one is trying to use the wave sun driver. The first graphics command after using set\_plot,'sun' will result in a segmentation fault. Would this be an accurate description of your problem? My understanding is that the wave x driver is working fine in 4.1.2. and you may want to use the x driver while we investigate the SunView situation.
