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Hi,

I have four arraies

```
all_time = fltarr(10000)
```

```
all_location = fltarr(3, 10000)
```

```
sel_time = fltarr(4000)
```

```
sel_location = fltarr(3,4000)
```

the 'sel_time' is a subset of 'all_time'. Is there a quick way I could find index 'j' of all_time for each sel_time(i) (when $\text{abs}(\text{all_time}(j) - \text{sel_time}(i)) \leq 1e-5$)? So I could use that index to pick the sel_location from all_location for each sel_time(i). Since I have multiple(~20000) such tests, loop through both of them will be too time consuming.

Should I sort both all_time and sel_time to descent/ascent order to speed it up?
