Benjamin,

There's no way to set a group leader for an iTool. However, to close an iTool programatically you can use either the itDelete or itReset commands.

itDelete will close a single tool. So, for example:

```
IDL> iplot,findgen(10),IDENTIFIER=idPlot
```

```
IDL> itDelete, idPlot
```

itReset will reset the entire iTools system, so it's useful if you want to close multiple tool windows at once.

Note that there are some iTools dialogs which are tool-independent (like the Macro Editor and Style Editor windows), and if these are open, they won't be closed after calling itDelete. To close those you have to use itReset.

I forgot to mention that you need to use the KILL_NOTIFY keyword when creating your top-level base widget, and put the call to itReset/itDelete in your kill notify procedure.
