we have a license server running on Solaris 8 (SPARC) and can connect to it from a Solaris 10 x86 machine using IDL 5.5a for Solaris x86.
All of the IDL functions I normally use in IDL are okay. As this is an old version of IDL it isn't supported by RSI.

I've asked if RSI will be support Solaris x86 again and they said they will if there is enough interest. Why not write to them if you would like a native version?
