I am trying to round to the nearest tenth, and it works most of the time. It doesn't work if the value is 5.05 or 5.55, which get rounded to 5.0 and 5.5, respectively, instead of 5.1 and 5.6. When I type it into the command line, it works as expected, but not when I run the entire program.

Here is the code (which I have divided into steps to see where it's going wrong--it still doesn't work if I do the same thing in one line of code):

```
;** Round off the value.  
help, value  
print, value  
temp = value * 10.0  
help, temp  
print, temp  
rounded_value = ROUND(temp)  
help, rounded_value  
print, rounded_value  
value = rounded_value/10.0  
help, value  
print, value
```

Here is the output:

```
VALUE    FLOAT    =    5.05000  
5.05000  
TEMP     FLOAT    =    50.5000  
50.5000  
ROUNDED_VALUE LONG    =    50  
50  
VALUE    FLOAT    =    5.00000  
5.00000
```

Why does it not round properly?
