- > I have one parameter which can be -1 or 1, nothing else, but I'm having
- > problems to do this with PARINFO.

- > Probably there is an easier way to do it but I am setting limits=[-1,1],
- > then I set the min and the max step to 2. I thought that this would do
- > keep this parameter in -1 or in 1, but I get values like 0.8 or 0.9. Any
- > ideas?

Call MPFITFUN twice, once with parameter -1 fixed, once with 1 fixed, and compare the resulting Chi-square. Or alter your code such that [-1,0] maps to -1, and [0,1] maps to 1. This method is fairly rude, because the fitter will take tiny steps looking for any change, and finding none, may get quite confused.
