No experience, but ...

> I'm having some problems with the establishment of the telnet session

... you are correct. There is some negotiation to the Telnet protocol, it's not just text over TCP/IP. If you don't implement it properly, you won't be able to talk to a telnet server. See RFC854.

You might want to search for alternatives, though.
