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ION script offers replacements for html check-boxes and radio-buttons with the characteristic that they retain their state on page reloading. But not, for example, for a drop-down. I'm wondering whether this is because there's a trivial way to do that programmatically (I know very little about html - I'm learning it through ION script...), or it's just tough luck.

This is what the html looks like - I'd like to keep the 'selected' in the right place. I could, of course, write some IDL to generate the code, I suppose...
