It's been a long time since I've used ERDAS - are you sure it can read floating point images? My guess is either that it can't, or that the ENVI_OUTPUT_TO_EXTERNAL_FORMAT routine is written to only work on certain data types and converts any input data into one of those formats if it isn't already in one.

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I figured it out. I had the IMAGINE keyword set to ERDAS instead of IMAGINE and it seemed to output to an older ERDAS format, which you are probably right did not read floating point, current versions do.
