Hi,

That is a pretty general question - which makes it hard to answer. Have you looked in the Image Processing in IDL online guide? You should start there. In that guide there is a brief instruction on how to segment an image, identify connected components and label them (using LABEL\_REGION) and fish them out (using HISTOGRAM).

You could also type ?image processing at the IDL command line. In IDL 6.3's online help it brings up a gold mine of tidbits.
