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I had a question about the THIN function in IDL. I was under the impression that this operation was supposed to preserve connectivity. Am I mistaken? The IDL implementation does not seem to do so.

The image linked below is output from a program I wrote. It simply takes the image on the left and applies the THIN function, yielding the image on the right. (Note the gap that forms toward the bottom.)
