Hi All,

I'm having trouble resizing a byte array that's contained within a structure. Since I need the array to be larger, I can't use REFORM, and since it must become an arbitrary size I can't use REBIN, thus I'm trying to use CONGRID.

In my code I have the statements,

```
HELP, struct.data  
struct.data = CONGRID(struct.data, 512, 512)
```

Running the program, I get this output in the console:

```
<Expression>  BYTE    = Array[512, 300]  
Conflicting data structures: structure tag,<BYTE    Array[512, 512]>.
```

Anyone know how I can get around this?
