> Does anyone know how to get the PLOTS routine to use a given color? Specifically, when
> the device is in xor drawing mode?

If you are drawing in xor mode, the actual color index will be the inverted value of the color which was already there, so in 8-bits: 255 gets 0 and %111100000 gets %00011111. So it is not easy to specify the color when in the xor-mode. One possible solution is to draw only to a few bitplanes by using the command DEVICE, Set_Write_Mask.
