```
s1={a:0,b:0,c:0}
```

```
s2=replicate(s1,10)
```

Is there a way to expand this array by another tag "d" so that essentially every array index contains the structure {a,b,c,d}?

The reason why I don't include "d" right away is that I read the structure content from files, where the additional variable is not available.

I have looked at `struct_assign` and `create_struct`, but I don't think they can do what I want.

Does anyone have any idea except copying every freakin' tag separately???
