While I wait for Ronn Kling's book to arrive, perhaps someone can help me.

iPlot's selection of marker types are all 2-dimensional. They look pretty ugly in 3-D and disappear when viewed edge on(!). (I'll submit a feature request to ITTVIS to see if they can add 3-D markers.)

In the meantime, I would like to try to "manually" plot 3-D markers at selected points. I have found several primitive solid objects through this group, but I don't know much about object graphics, so it is not clear how to display them in an existing iTool.

Small spheres would be nice, and I don't need to display a lot of them, so performance should not be an issue.

Any help would be greatly appreciated.
