I have read about different ways to log the idl outputs (errors and others). But I have a problem in a different way.
I have an idl process which is running in a machine which I connect using ssh. Because of limitations of the firewall my ssh session is closed after a certain time. If I login again by ssh, I can see that the process is running yet (\$top).
The problem is that I have not previously defined a log file with journal or in a similar way. So, is it possible to obtain a log file of the current running idl program with the possible error output?. I am not sure about if it is possible with modifications of the stdout in the GNU/Linux remote system or the "catcher" tip by David.
