M-x byte-compile-file <RET>

The M-x is emacs-speak for pressing the meta key and then the x key. Usually, the meta key is the escape key. It will then prompt you for the name of the file. You should enter the name of the .el file to compile, including the path to it.

- > 2. what are the other files (wave-indent.el, wave-mode-hook.el) for?
- > 3. do they have to be installed the same way?
- > 4. when editing a wave program in xemacs only comments and strings are
- > highlighted in different colours. is it possible to get also statements
- > highlighted?
