I tried to run a script like this (stored in test.pro):

```
array = ['one', 'two', 'three']
print, array
n = N_ELEMENTS(array)
print, n
FOR i=0,n-1 DO BEGIN
    PRINT, array[i]
ENDFOR
```

However, I got error message as follows:

```
IDL> @test
one two three
      3
Attempt to subscript ARRAY with I is out of range.
Execution halted at: $MAIN$

ENDFOR
^
Syntax error.
At: E:\temp\test.pro, Line 7
```

This is an example from IDL. Do you have any idea about what is going on?
