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Hi,

I tried using SetPixelData to write a 2D processed data into DICOM image. I used the Bits_Allocated to be same as the information I read from the header of the raw data (DICOM file).

```
olmg -> SetPixelData, image[:,*,i], BITS_ALLOCATED = uid2805,  
PHOTOMETRIC_INTERPRETATION = 'MONOCHROME2',  
SAMPLES_PER_PIXEL = 1, PIXEL_REPRESENTATION = 0, COLUMNS = imsize[1],  
ROWS = imsize[2]
```
