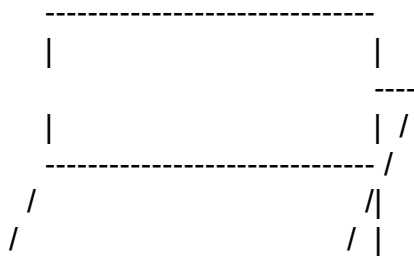

Subject: 2 slices in 3D space
