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You are very close. I think you just want to use the "Save" operation instead of "Save As". "Save As" will always prompt for a filename. So your code would look like:

```
it = itgetcurrent(Tool=oTool)
op = oTool->GetByIdentifier(oTool->GetFullIdentifier()+'/OPERATIONS/
FILE/SAVE')
op->SetProperty, filename='c:/test.isv', show_execution_ui=0
void = oTool->DoAction(op->GetFullIdentifier())
```
