Sorry David,

My schedule as of late doesn't allow much time to spend hanging out here :(.

I've been in touch with your customer. That function is in the dlm and the issue is that a) IDL can't find the .dll, and b) once it does you'll find the .dll you are using has been linked against idl32.lib which was deprecated in 6.4 with the move to support x86-64. So first you need a new .dll and then you need to set IDL up to find it. Being lazy, I always throw my .dlms into the IDL bin directory. I know there are other/better ways to do this but it works for me.

I'll send you the recompiled dll directly. At some point when I get time I will post it online.
