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Greetings IDL comrades!

I imagine I'm overlooking something simple here, but I need to find the position of a plot after (or before) its been made; something along these lines:

```
!p.multi=[0,2,2]  
plot, findgen(10)
```

now, what is the position vector (e.g., something like: [1,.45,.45,.9]) for this first frame? or for the second, etc.

I've tried `print,!p.position`, which gives [0,0,0,0], which doesn't help me at all.

It seems like it would be possible that once you've specified `!p.multi` you should be able to find out what the position of the plot frames are, but I've had no luck figuring out how to do this after a long time wandering in the IDL documentation wilderness.
