I am writing a GUI program using the IDL GUI builder. I put a checkbox on the GUI, and that checkbox state should be checked when a specific button is pressed. The code is handled inside the x_eventcb.pro file.

Question is: How can I check the state of the checkbox (checked/unchecked)? Can somebody give me an example?

I've read through the IDL help and several topics on this newsgroup, but I couldn't find a fitting solution for my rather simple problem.

I know how to set the state with "Widget_control, buttonname, set_button = 1" but since there is no "get_button" I'm quite puzzled how to get the state.
