```
System.exit(0);
```

HelloWorld.java:

```
public class HelloWorld{  
public HelloWorld(){  
System.out.println("Hello.");  
}  
public void quit(){  
System.exit(1);  
}  
}
```

importer.pro:

```
pro importer  
asdf = obj_new('IDLJavaObject$HELLOWORLD', $  
  'HelloWorld')  
  asdf->quit  
  obj_destroy, asdf  
end
```

This line breaks IDL whereby I have to end the process and restart IDL.

Is there any way around this ?
