> used dialog_pickfile and tried to import multiple images its not
> working. I want to know how to import multiple images and send those
> values into as ascii or text file.The file format is TIFF.Thanks in
> advance.

It is not clear (to me, anyway) what you want to do.

If you want a separate ASCII file for each image, then just open, write, and close the ASCII file in your image loop. If you just want one ASCII file, then open and close the file outside the loop, and write to it inside the loop.
