> I have a relatively simple problem: For transparencies  
> it is sometimes useful to keep the background color  
> 'black'. The IDL Postscript-device, however, swaps  
> foreground and background colors as compared to the  
> 'X' device. How do I get around this default? I have  
> tried changing |p.background and |p.color or modifying  
> the color table. The plots are generated by 'standard'  
> shade\_surf, plot etc. commands (no images). Screen-dumps  
> look OK, but the resolution is not satisfactory.
